- Dress Code: No denim, short shorts, or tank tops. Golf shirts must have collars, or appropriate polo neck top.
- No outside alcoholic beverages are permitted on course
- Pay attention to players assistant, adhere to their direction.
- Keep up the pace of play. If a clear hole is open in front of you, alert the other members of your foursome, and speed up your play.
- Wave up on all par three's if group behind is waiting and ready to hit.
- Play ready golf. Always be ready to play when it is your turn. The player whose ball is farthest from the hole is up.
- Limit yourself to one practice swing.
- When a hole is completed, replace the flag properly in the hole, and leave the green quickly.
- Limit the search for a lost ball to three minutes. If a ball is not found immediately, signal the following group to play through.
- On the tee, the player who has the honor (clear winner of the previous hole) hits first. If there is no clear winner, use the same order as on the previous hole.
- Do not move, talk, stand close by, or stand directly behind the ball, when another player is addressing his ball or making a stroke.
- Do not stand behind the ball or in the line of sight of another player's putt.
- Replace and tramp down all divots on the fairway.
- Repair your ball marks on the green and one other.
- Repair and rake all bunkers. Leave by the low side; do not climb up steep banks. Leave rakes in bunkers – handles out.
- Do not bring your golf bag onto the green. Do not bring your cart onto the apron of the green. Do not leave your cart at the front of the green. Bags and carts should be placed at the side or back of the green in the direction of the next tee.
- Never play a shot until the players in front of you are out of range.
- Prior to making a stroke or practice swing, make sure that none of the members of your foursome are standing where they could be hit by the club, the ball, or any stones or twigs that may be moved by the swing.
- No cell phones or pagers on the course except for emergency please turn ringers off.
- Golf is a gentleman's recreation and as a member of the Nico Wynd Golf Men's Club and by signing the agreement on the yearly registration form, I agree to conduct myself in a gentlemanly manner and know that should I become discomposed during any organized event that I may be brought forward to the executive for investigation which could conclude in discipline or ultimately my expulsion from the NWMGC for a time period decided by the Executive.
