ABOUT OUR CLUBS

We are a group of men who meet and play organized club events on Saturdays, Tuesdays (or both) at Nico Wynd Golf Course in South Surrey. The summer season runs from March until the end of October and the winter season runs from November to mid-March. Events during the summer season include stroke play, stableford, one man and two man match play and other variations from year to year. Club Championships, Ace of the Month/Year and other events lead up to the Annual Awards Banquet in October.

Although there is competition and adherence to the Rules of Golf, you will find our members friendly and welcoming to players of all abilities.

Potential new members who lack a current golf handicap will ideally have a collection of recorded scores and courses. Otherwise a handicap will be established after a review and a set number of games.

Our relationship with the course assures us of 18 holes of play not available to the general public. Green fees are not included with the membership and are set by the golf course. They do offer our members special discounts on a variety of pass options to reduce overall costs.

MEMBERSHIP AND EVENT FEES

All fees are adjusted annually. There is a annual fee for Saturdays (19 years +), one for Tuesdays (55 years +) and a substantially discounted combination fee for both days. New applicants will be advised if there is a waiting list for either day. The annual fee is for both the summer & winter seasons and runs from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31.

Event fees are adjusted annually and cover prize pools by handicap division, deuce pots, long putts/drive, hole-in-one insurance and a meal included with your game entry multiple times per season.

THINGS TO KNOW

Returning members who meet the registration deadline are given priority every year.

We do follow the Rules of Golf as there are prizes every week. Our members will gladly answer any questions about this so don't be afraid to ask. The course does have some requirements about proper golf attire that we ask our members to respect. (IE no jeans, tank tops)

Members sign-up for tee times on the club website well in advance and can request early, middle or late times. Although you may request to play with specific individuals, foursomes are occasionally mixed up during the season so new players get to meet everyone in the club. The first starting times move with daylight during the season and can range from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM depending on the time of year. Tee times are posted on our website as well as being sent out several days in advance. Groups are sent out in 8 or 9 minute intervals. Local and club rules are noted on the tee sheets or at the course and include things such as preferred lies, bunker closures, temporary greens, etc. We do permit the use of GPS and rangefinders.

After Your Round

Signed and attested score cards are submitted to the respective Club Captains after the round and it is al-

ways best to compare cards with your playing partners. Results and prize winners are cirthe table to the table table to the table same or next day. Handicaps are adjusted after each round. Members are asked to

post scores from other courses that they play.

Socializing

Friendly and competitive golf is only part of our club's appeal. Many members choose to stay and socialize with other players on the expanded Nico Wynd deck and patio and that is a great way to meet others in

Waiting lists

New member applicants may find themselves on a waiting list due to the popularity of the clubs (most often the Tuesday group). You will be given an estimate of how long of a wait to expect. Members who play at least 10 rounds on Saturdays will benefit from some priority consideration for Tuesday play.

Our History

Our club goes back to 1979 with the design and construction of the course by investor and first Nico Wynd resident, Herb Fritz. Fourteen players (almost all non-residents) formed a regular Sunday morning club in May 1980.


Membership numbers continued to grow quickly over the next few years requiring shotgun starts and eventually a move to Saturdays from Sundays and a division of the club into a Seniors group who moved to Tuesdays.

Good drainage, compared to many other area

courses, led to the establishment of a winter season and that brought in even more players from surrounding clubs.

With the arrival of Covid, a worldwide decline in golf popularity was reversed and our membership roles experienced a big bounce back. We now average a membership of about 140 players and weekly fields are often filled to the maxi-
