The 2025 Summer Season Nicowynd Senior Men's League Is now underway. Following is a little update on the start of the season. Some of it is repetitive.

- 1. I think registration for the season is now mostly complete. Members have signed up for events they would like to attend. I will adjust the type of events during the season to meet the demand for play. This means there could be a number of 7:30 Shotgun Tournaments. I expect our first shotgun tournament will be April 8 (April Ace of Month).. You should expect the majority of summer events to be shotguns.
- 2. Registration for Single Match Play tournament is now available through WhatsApp events published on March 17. It appears about 40 or so members have signed up so far. If you would like to join and cannot select the WhatsApp event, just send me a message. WhatsApp also has an option of NOT to play, so you can click on that if you do not wish to participate. There is space for up to 64 members. Day 1 on April 29 and Day 2 on May 6 will be for a maximum field of 64 and those days will be fully devoted to match play only. There will be No alternate event on those two days.

- 4. May 20th and 27th will be the 'overflow' days for match play tournament for the rescheduled. Final 8 players will then be determined and the quarter finals, semi-finals and final will follow.
- 5. May 13 is the first event with a meal. It may be are only meal event for season based on budget considerations. The event will be a shotgun with a burger meal to follow.
- 6. Summer rules will come into effect as soon as weather and course conditions allow.
- 7. The Club Championship will be on Tuesday July 22 and Thursday July 24. Participants must signup for both days. There is no alternate event during for these days. Players must have played 10 events in 2025 to qualify.
- 8. You should arrive at the course a minimum of twenty minutes prior to your scheduled tee time. If you are late you will be DQ'd. We will play all events rain or shine unless the course is closed.
- 9. All players are expected to keep score with their group. Incorrectly completed scorecards with lower score than actual on any hole is a disqualification. Higher scores than actual remain.
- 10. When you arrive at the club, you should first pay your green fees. Let the staff know whether you are an owner, a punch card holder, a pass holder or pay-as-you go.
- 11. The hole in one policy will be posted on our website.
- 12. Golf Etiquette expectations are posted on our website. There is a dress code! No denim!

- 13. Event fees and winnings are reconciled every two months. You may receive statements during the two month period. I prefer payment and winnings to be processed through Interac Etransfer. If you have a bank account you can set this up through your bank. Most banks will offer this service at no charge (if you ask). My Interac email is <u>taylor58@telus.net</u> It is setup with autodeposit and does not require any security question. Do not use any other email as they will not work for etransfer purposes. For those still living in the last century, I will accept cash.
- 14. All members are expected to enter casual scores from other rounds into our e-handicap system. I will enter the scores for Tuesday Events. If you need any assistance please just ask.
